



Bridge #15

Big Indian Rd approximately two miles outside of Corydon

Harrison County Bridge #15 is a 20'-4" span wood deck bridge located on Big Indian Rd approximately two miles outside of Corydon. Bridge #15 has a 9 ton load rating and was identified as priority #2 for replacement in the 2004 Harrison County Bridge Inspection Report. In 2006, Harrison County Contracted with Jacobi, Toombs, & Lanz, Inc. (JTL) from Clarksville to design a replacement structure for Bridge #15. The proposed new structure will be constructed of pre-cast concrete box beams on poured in place concrete footers and abutments. The new bridge will be constructed on a skew and include reconstruction of Big Indian Rd as it approaches Bridge #15 eliminating the sharp 90 degree curve on the north side of the bridge. We anticipate that JTL will complete the plans for Bridge #15 in 2007 allowing Right-of-Way acquisition to begin in late 2007 and construction in 2008.
